

# **SPRING & SUMMER ADULT HOCKEY LEAGUE**

**League Philosophy:** The purpose of the League is to provide an opportunity for players of all abilities to participate in structured competition. The “no bodychecking” rule has been applied to all divisions to ensure players are not injured.

**League Management:** All games are scheduled by the Dakota Community Centre and governed by the full time program manager. All game day officials are included in the team cost.

**Divisions:** The spring and summer leagues will consist of 4 divisions. Division 1 is for the highest skilled teams/players. Teams may be moved from one division to another throughout the league to create better balance.

**Game Times:** Spring Adult Hockey League will play **12 games minimum**. Summer Adult Hockey League will play **18 games minimum**. Daily schedules for hockey range from Monday through Sunday, games will be 3 – 12 minute stop time periods.

Note: **During the Summer Adult Hockey League Saturday games are excluded**

**League Rules:** CHA rules shall apply with the following exceptions; no red-line for offside pass, delayed offsides and no body checking. The centre line will be used for icings only. All rules will be enforced to their fullest extent to ensure a positive recreational experience. A zero tolerance policy is in place in terms of verbal abuse towards officials, and any disciplinary problems may result in suspensions by the program manager without refund.

**Registration:** Registration is encouraged on a team basis. Individual players are welcome. Each team must provide their own matching numbered uniforms. Space is limited!

**Spring Hockey League: \$2000.00/Team with GST**

**Summer Hockey League: \$2550.00/Team with GST**
